Government Degree college for women, Ongole and Government Degree college, Chebrole associated to conduct an online 5-day Faculty Development Programme on Revised NAAC Accreditation process & ICT Tools from 26th to 30th June, 2020. NAAC accreditation determines the quality of institutions in terms of seven vital criteria as the basis of assessment procedure. So, we focussed on those 7 criteria and organised FDP to the faculty, this is a comprehensive rundown of NAAC procedure which makes the faculty to breathe easy while compilation. Also, an overall outlook on ICT tools for online teaching-learning techniques in view of COVID-19 pandemic was provided.

Objectives:

- ☐ To educate and train faculties of colleges about revised NAAC accreditation procedure.
- ☐ To upgrade about various Criteria, qualitative and quantitative metrics of NAAC.
- ☐ To Interact with various experts in NAAC and resolve the problems faced during NAAC Accreditation process in their respective colleges.
- ☐ To train faculty on ICT tools like G suite, google class rooms etc.
- ☐ Time: 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and 4.00 pm to 5.00 pm

Execution:

The 5 day online FDP programme through google meet started with opening remarks by Dr.D.Kalyani ,Principal, D.S.GDCW Ongole . Dr.V.Sridevi, Principal, GDC,Chebrole invited chief guest of the FDP Dr.P. Anil Kumar, Academic officer, Academic cell , Commissionerate of Collegiate education ,Andhra Pradesh to deliver his keynote address on importance of Best practices on Institutional efficacy .He also appreciated the initiative taken by organisers to conduct FDP. Later inaugural was ended by the vote of thanks.

DAY-1: The 1st session has started by Dr. K.Padmaja, Professor , Department ,of English & IQAC Coordinator, D.K.W.Autonomous College, Nellore, AP. She explained on Prerequisites- Overall review on NAAC procedure- how IQAC can be the pivotal aspect of an institution. The IQAC is responsible for all 'Quality Assurance' giving attention to every stage of educational processes and support systems in colleges, to achieve and maintain a desired level of quality. She discussed the processes and required procedure that needs to be completed before any institution applies for NAAC accreditation.

In 2nd session Dr.B.Varalakshmi, Rtd. Reader in English, GDCW Autonomous, Guntur, had greatly deliberated the specific aspects of Criterion 1. Curricular Aspect, one of the important criteria among seven criteria to assess the quality of higher education institution. She stated that curriculum is the essential constituent of any education system irrespective of the education level. All other aspects revolve around it.

DAY-2: Dr.B.Varalakshmi, Rtd. Reader in English, GDCW Autonomous, Guntur, explained well on Teaching-Learning and Evaluation, and discussed the Student enrolment and profile, catering to student diversity, teaching-learning process, teacher profile and quality, evaluation process and reform, student performance and intelligent quotient along with her own illustration of experience.

In 2nd session Sri.J.N.Suresh kumar ,Full time Mentor, Jawahar knowledge centre, DSGDCW, Ongole, had explained technical session on Google suite. He explained with demonstration about

importance of G Suite in higher education. It is a suite of cloud computing, productivity and collaboration tools, software and products developed by Google.

DAY-3: Morning session was again on remaining part of Criterion 2 which is a highly scoring aspect among 7 criterion. Dr.B.Varalakshmi, Rtd. Reader in English, GDCW Autonomous, Guntur motivated on student satisfaction survey. Apart from this, she also taught the meaning of Course Outcome (CO), Program Outcome (PO), and Program Specific Outcome (PSO) with a good narration.

In 2nd session Sri.J.N.Suresh kumar ,Full time Mentor, Jawahar knowledge centre, DSGDCW, Ongole, had explained technical session on Google slides. He explained the difference of slides in power point presentation and google slides. Google Slides is a presentation program included as part of a free, web-based software office suite offered by Google within its Google Drive service. The service also includes Google Docs and Google Sheets, a word processor and spreadsheet respectively. Google Slides is available as a web application, mobile app for Android.

DAY-4: On day-4 of Online Faculty Development Programme Dr. K.Padmaja, Professor , Department of English & IQAC Coordinator, D.K.W.Autonomous College, Nellore, AP enlightened Criterion 3, 4 and 5 . The key indicators which were discussed in this session are Research Innovation and Extension on qualitative and quantitative metrics, validation of data by an external agency, quality indicator framework, research mobilization for research, extension, and collaboration. In Criterion 4 Infrastructure and Learning Resource i.e. Physical facilities, library as a learning resource, IT Infrastructure, Maintenance of Campus Infrastructure were explained. Similarly, on Criterion 5; Student Support and Progression, student participant activities and alumni engagements were discussed in detail.

In 2nd session Sri. J.N.Suresh kumar ,Full Time Mentor, Jawahar Knowledge Centre, DSGDCW, Ongole, explained technical session on Google Suite and Google Apps like Google Classroom, Docs, Sheets, Forms and Slides. Google Classroom is a free web service, developed by Google for Education, that aims to simplify creating, distributing, and grading assignments in a paperless way. The chief purpose of Google Classroom is to streamline the process of sharing files between teachers and students.

DAY-5: The morning session commenced with the guest speech of Dr.Ch.Tulasi, Academic Guidance officer, Academic cell, Commissionerate of Collegiate education, Andhra Pradesh gave very inspiring and motivated speech on faculty responsibilities. She complimented the collaborated colleges for conducting the FDP in a well organised manner.

First session was taken by Sri.M.Vincent Paul ,HOD, Dept of English, Sir C.R.R college, Autonomous, Eluru. He pondered Criterion 6 i.e. on Institutional Vision and Leadership, Strategy Development and Deployment, Faculty Empowerment Strategies and Internal Quality Assurance System.

Final session was also continued by Sri.M.Vincent Paul sir. He deliberated on, best practices, Institutional Values and Social Responsibilities, Institutional Distinctiveness the key metrics of Criterion 7.

Valedictory Session was chaired by Dr.D.Kalyani ,Principal, D.S.GDCW Ongole , she explained that the curricular aspects and the best practices connected to curriculum design and development play a very significant measurement of the quality of higher education since the curriculum has a decisive role in steering the other elements of quality. The 5 day FDP clinched with vote of thanks by Dr.P.V.Hemalatha, IQAC Coordinator, D.S.GDCW Ongole.

Out comes of the programme: To train faculties of colleges about NAAC guidelines. It gives elevation about various Criterion and new metrics formed by NAAC. Also, to share best practices that can be used for institutional development. We have provided a platform to Interact with various experts and resolve the problems facing during preparation of NAAC Accreditation process.

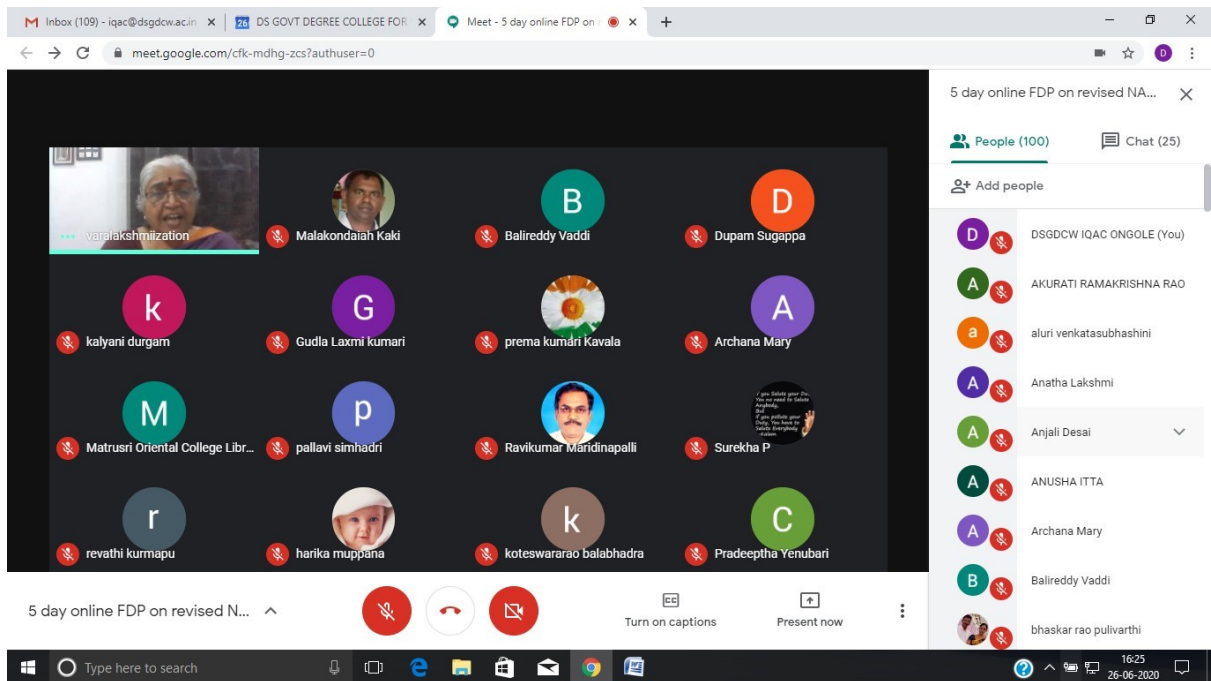

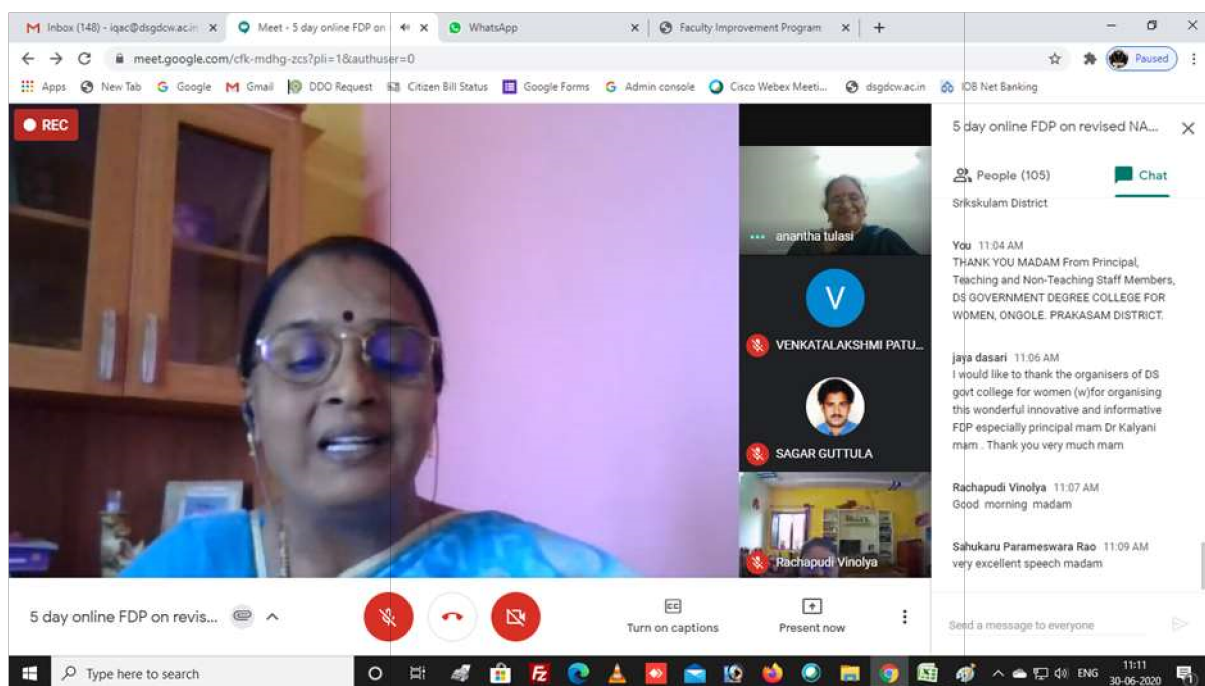

According to the statistics provided by Google forms 36.31/50 points stood as average score.

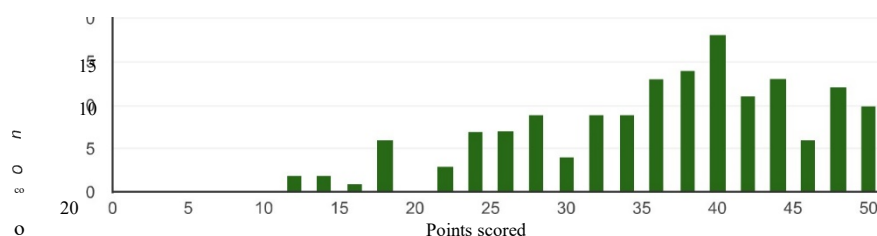

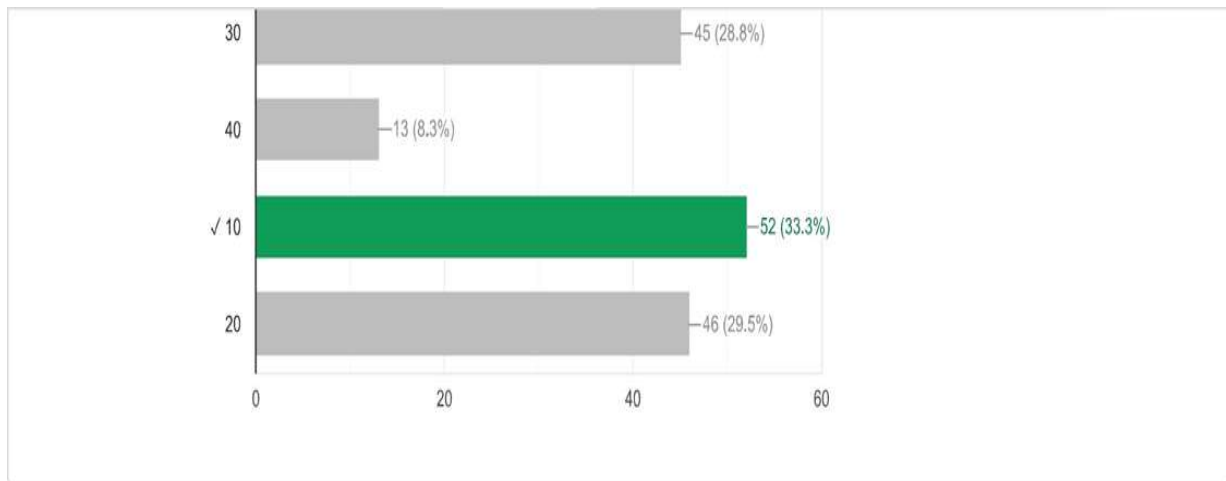
