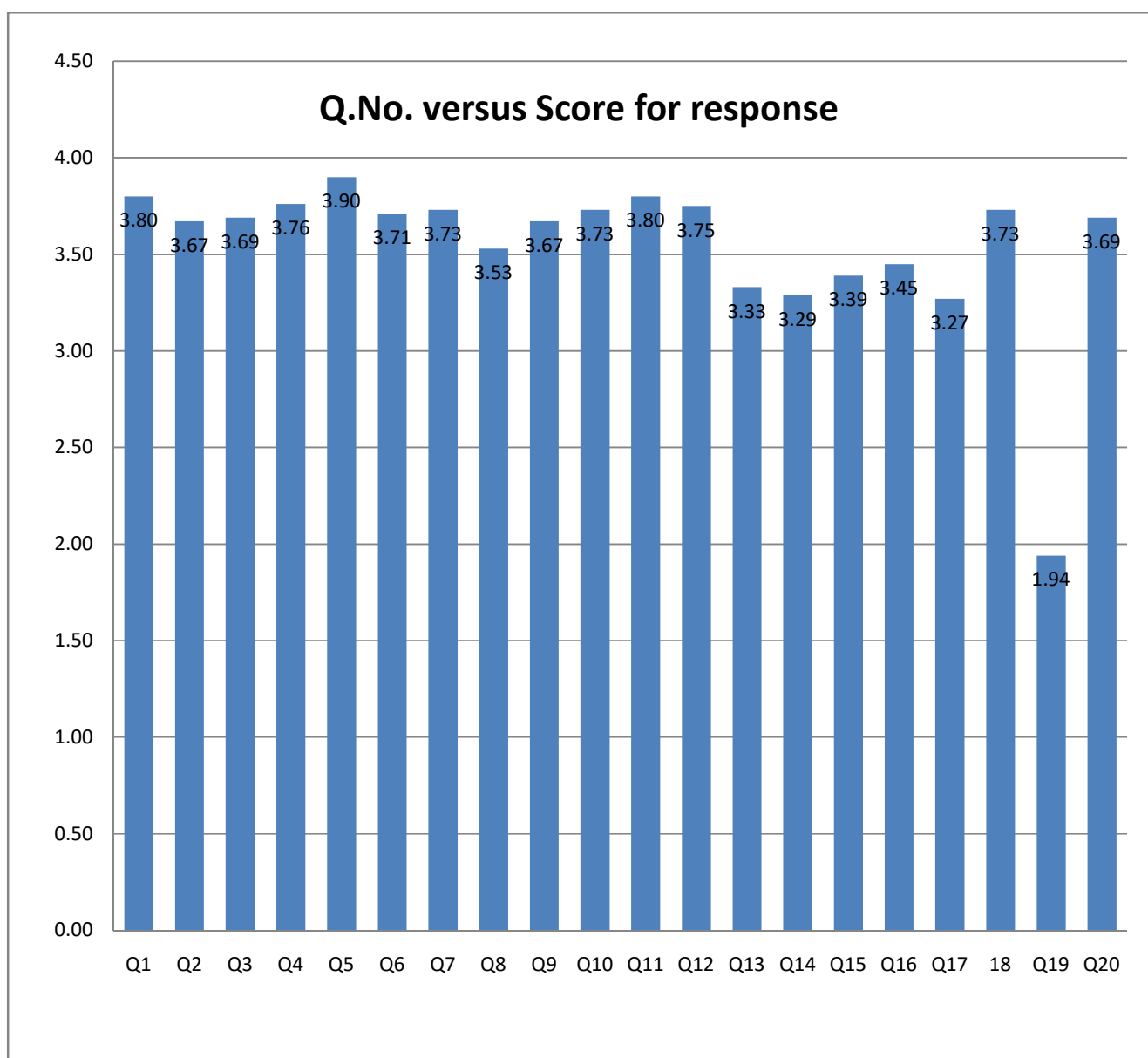

ANALYSIS OF STUDENTS SATISFACTORY SURVEY 2019-20

We received data from 51 Students in respect of 'Students Satisfactory Survey 2019-20'. The details of the various questions and the average score obtained are as follows. For every question, there are five answers in five-point scale as '4', '3', '2', '1', '0'. Answers '4' means Excellent, '3' means Very Good, '2' means Good and the answer with '4' or '3' or '2' indicate most satisfactory level. The answers '1' and '0' are treated as unsatisfactory response.

The average score obtained for each question is as follows.

- '4' or '3' or '2' indicate 'MOST SATISFACTORY' response to that question
- answers '1' and '0' are treated as 'UNSATISFACTORY' response to that question.
- For Q. No. 18 i.e., What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching?, the score obtained is 1.94 which is not satisfactory.
- As per this survey it is observed that ICT Tools and multimedia equipment use in teaching learning process should be enhanced to the satisfactory level.
