

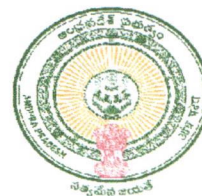

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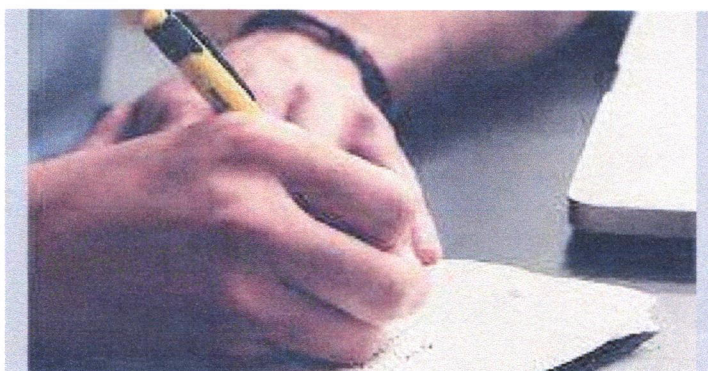

- ❖ It encouraged students to become responsible and discerning consumers of digital news content.

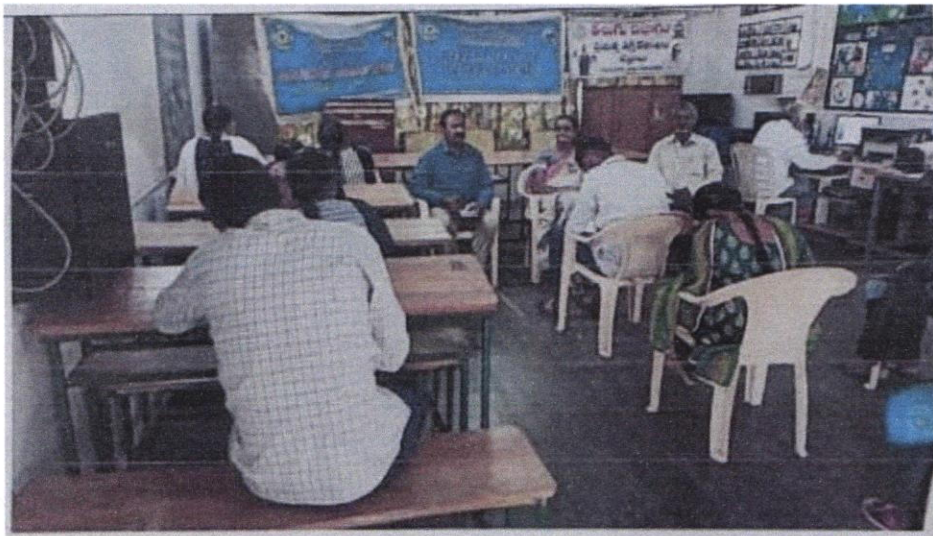
