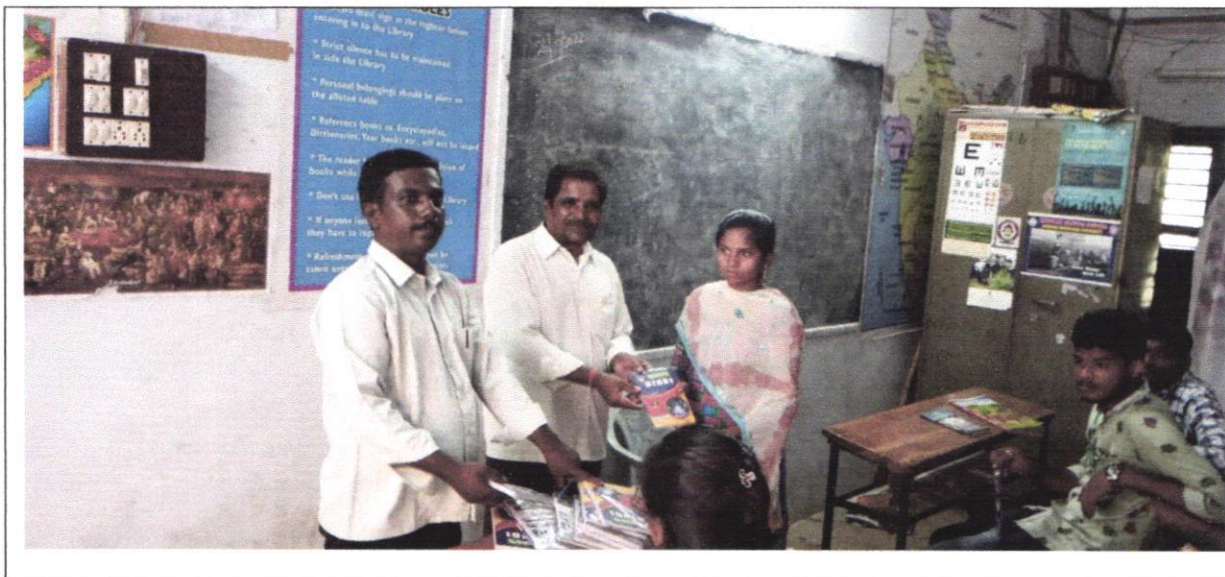

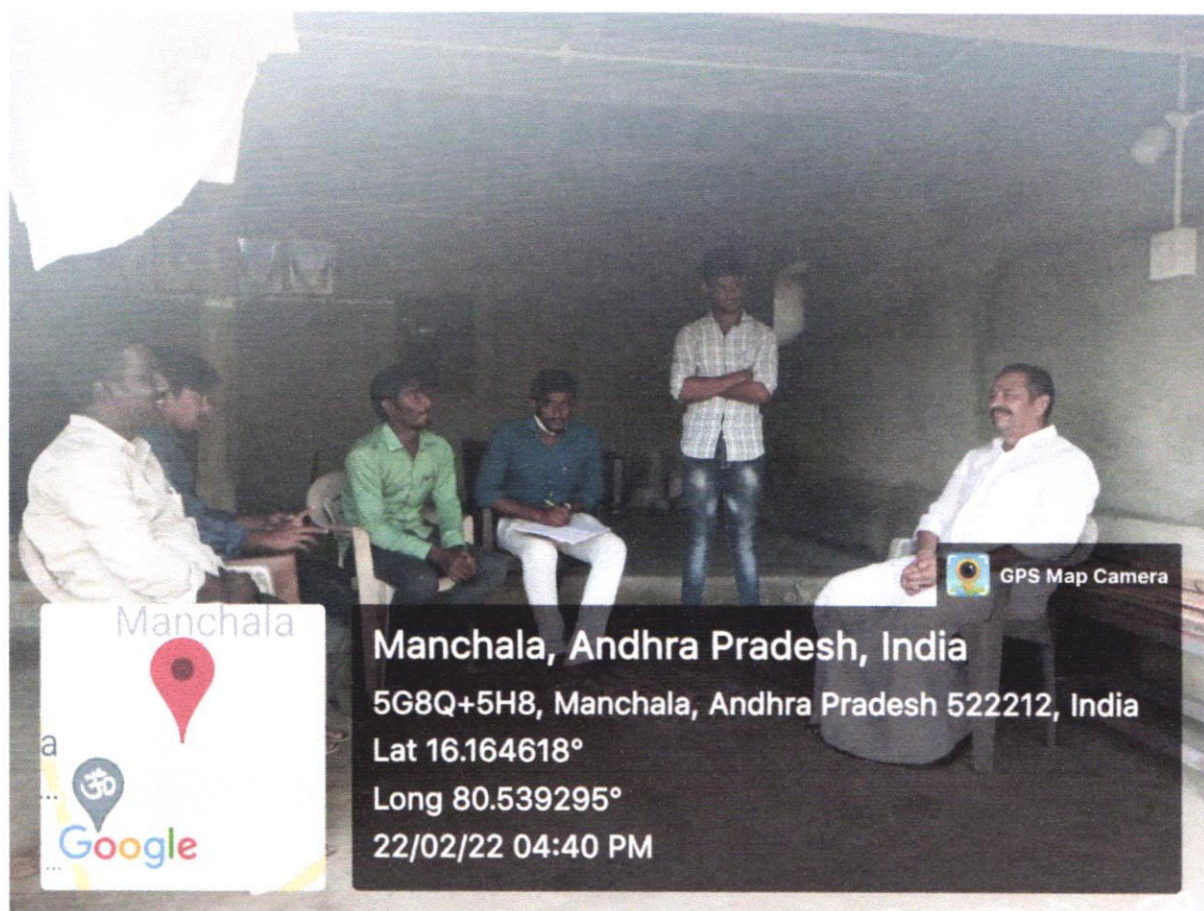

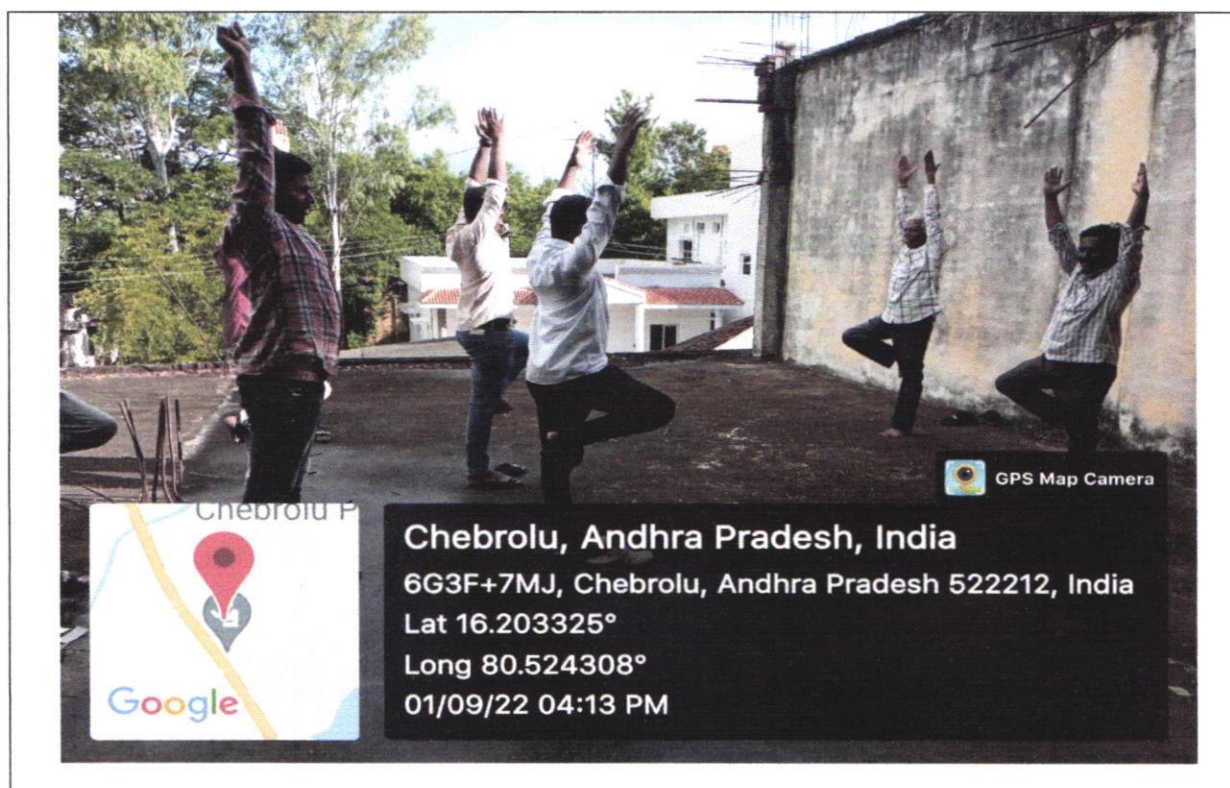

Activity: Yoga programme

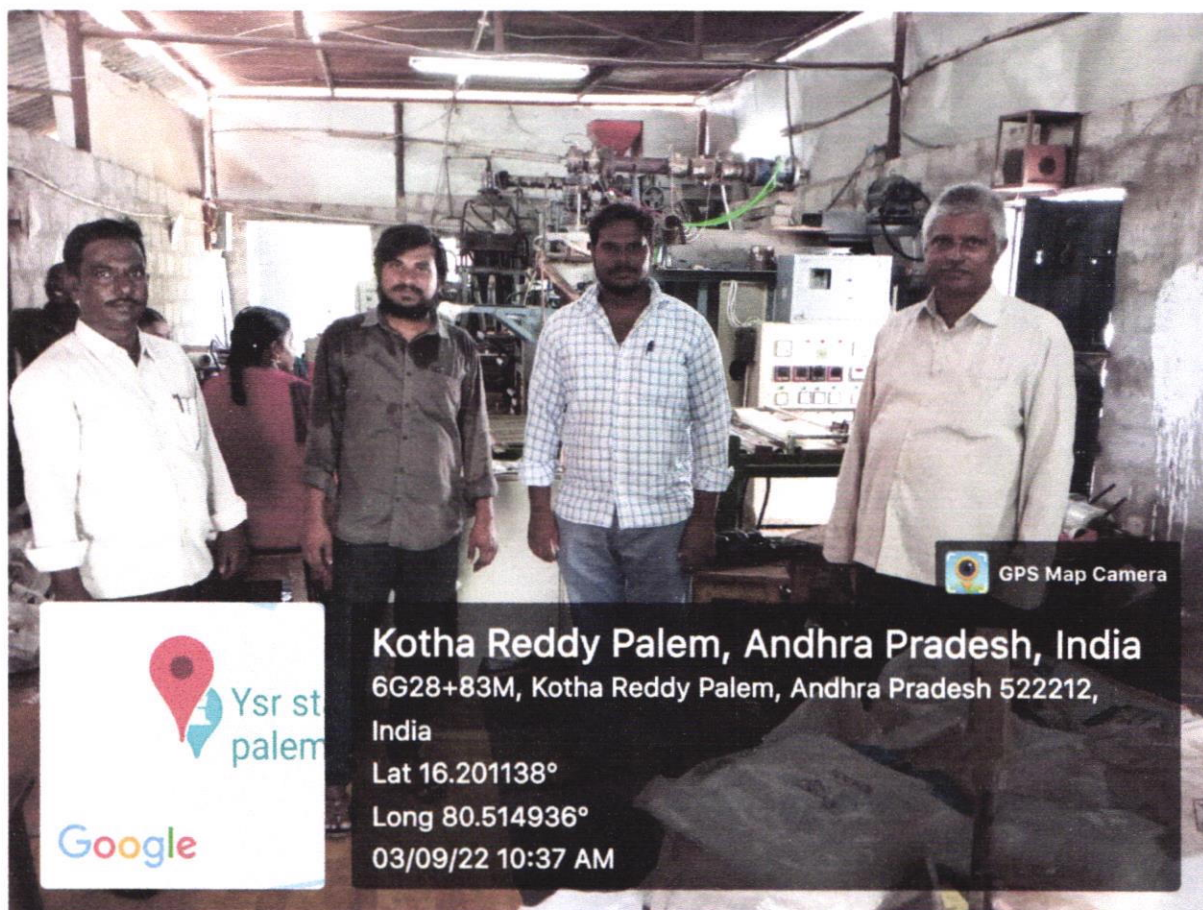


Aim: To conduct a yoga class

The Department of Hindi faculty best practices actively participated in the International Day of the Girl Child event.

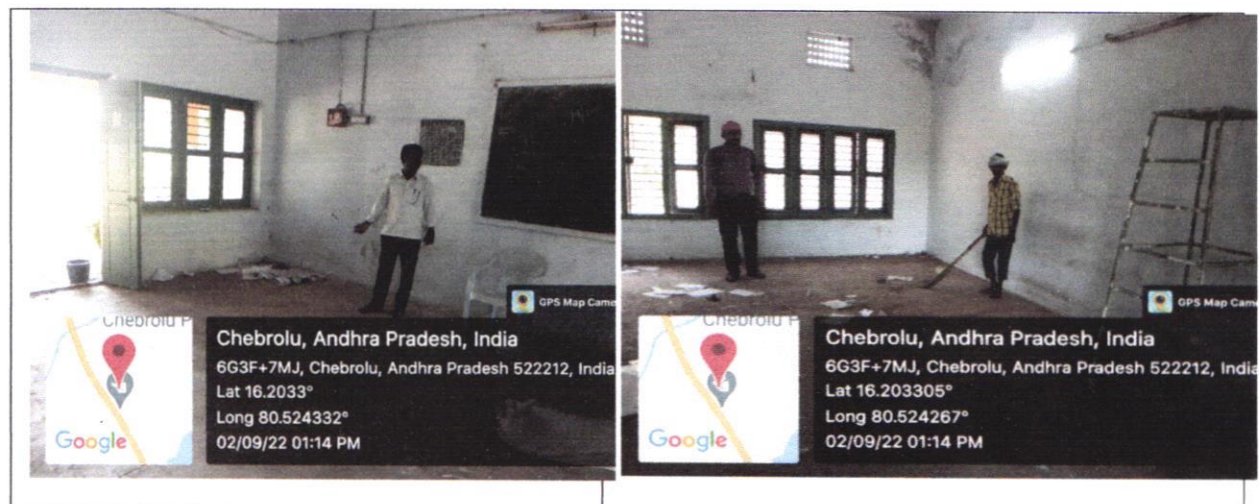
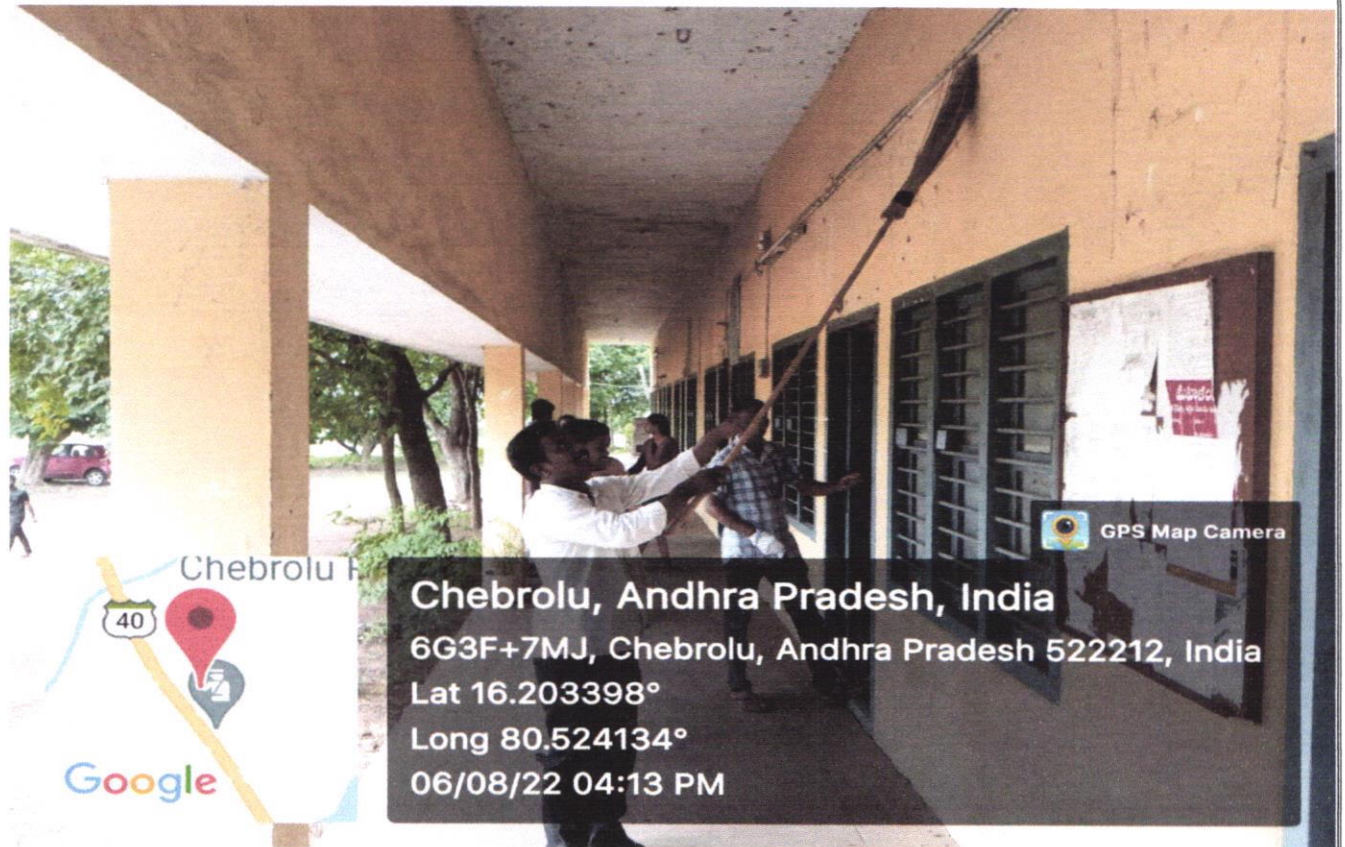
The main aim of our participation was twofold: to empower girls and amplify their collective voice on a global scale, and **to improve admissions to degree college.**
