- ❖ Attendees expressed a heightened sense of responsibility towards the environment.

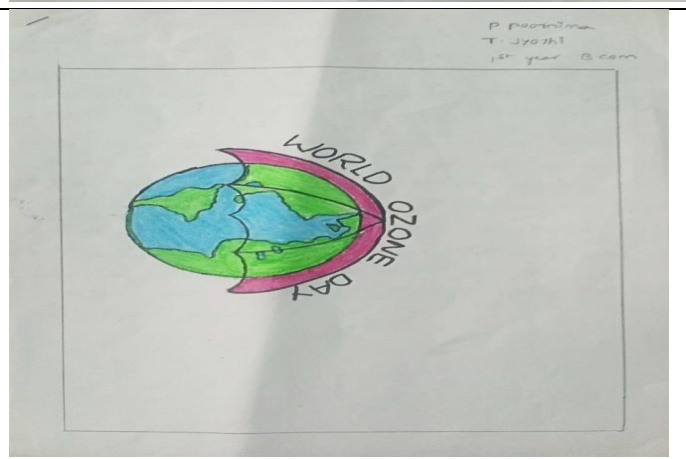
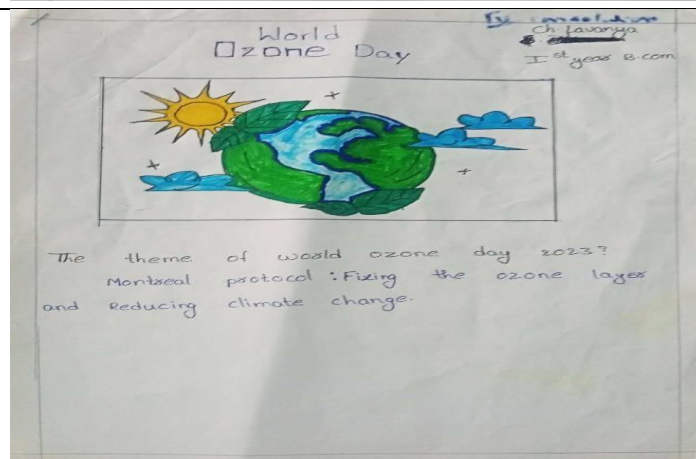
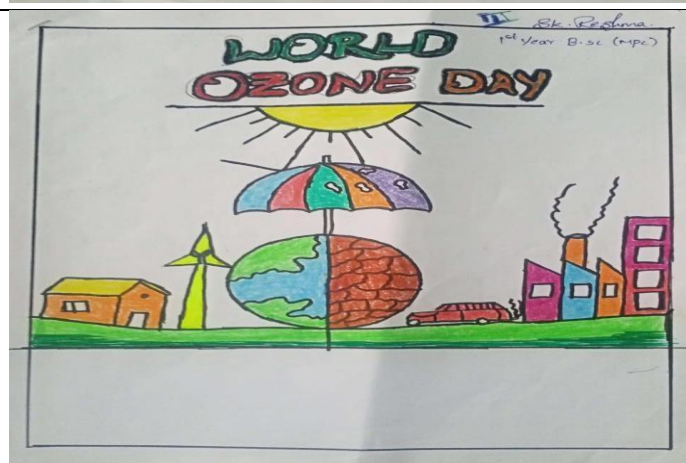
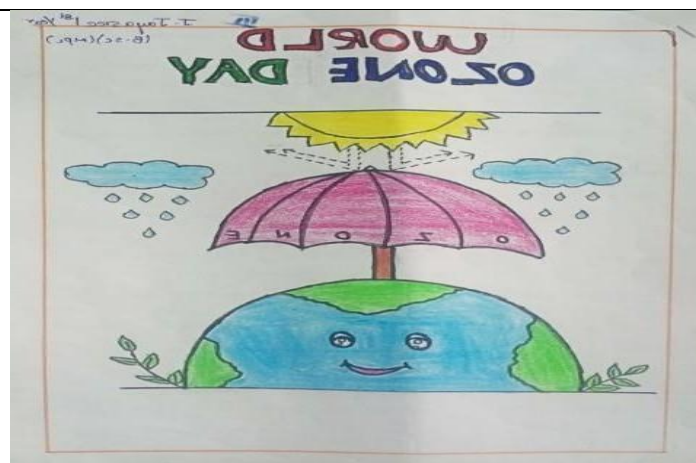
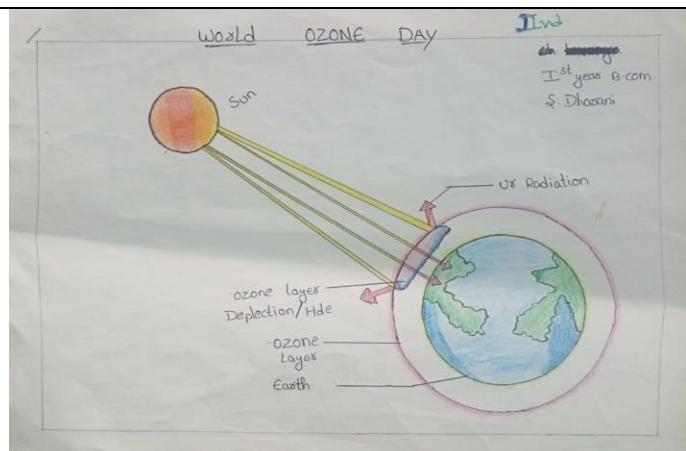
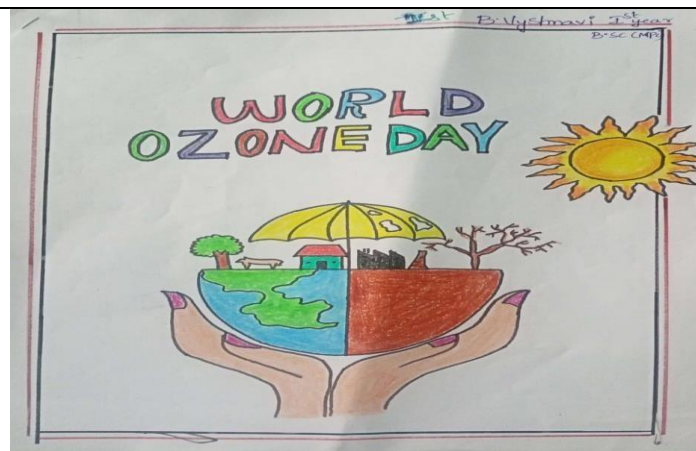
Artistic Expression and Creativity:

Objectives:

To convey the importance of the day and the service of the Sri Gurazada Venkata Apparao Jayanti and his literary contribution for Telugu language and Telugu nation.

Report:

Gurazada Apparao Jayanti is celebrated to know that how to implementation usual language in his literary work and how to influence to other poets and writers during his equilateral period.

Gurajada Venkata Apparao (21 September 1862 – 30 November 1915) was an Indian playwright, poet, and writer known for his works in Telugu theatre. Rao wrote the play Kanyasulkam in 1892, which is considered as the greatest play in the Telugu language.

Sri Gurajada Apparao was a social reformer, poet, writer, philosopher, and a friend. He was born in 1863 in Rayavaram of Visakhapatnam distt.. He graduated from the Maharaja's College (MR COLLEGE) of Vizianagaram, the so called VIDYANAGARAM of ANDHRA where he synthesized de novo the greatest of his writings which are superb, unforgettable, and immortal. "*Desamante matti kadoy Desamante manushuloy*" has had been shacking the hearts of every Telugu soul, whether literate or illiterate.

The style of Gurajada's poetry, neither pedantic nor enigmatic, but was the purest, crystal clear, lucid, and vivacious. His poems awaken the Weeklings even and energize them. Gurajada's intellectual creativity gave us a keepsake, historical landmark, and a precious literary diamond - "KANYASULKAM" play.

It is one and the only book in Telugu in which dedication and preface were written in English . On the 13th of August, 1992, "Kanyasulkam" celebrated its 100th birthday, ever since it was staged for the first time.

"Kanyasulkam" centenary celebrations were held at Gurajada's residence in Vizianagaram. Poets and writers from various places in Andhra held literary discourses on Gurajada's works. On the 76th death anniversary of Sri Gurajada, Sri Jonnalagadda Somayajulu and his party performed the "Kanyasulkam" play.

Sri Jonnalagadda Ramanamurty, well known for his Girisam role in the play, was honored. One will be surprised to know that the era of Modern Telugu Literature was born from Gurajada's pen and his "Kanyasulkam". "Kanyasulkam" was performed for the first time by the "Jagannadha Vilasini Sabha" of Vizianagaram in 1892.

To convey the importance of the day and the service of the Sri Gurram Jashuva Jayanti and his literary contribution for Telugu language and Telugu nation.

Report:

Gurram Jashuva (September 28, 1895 – July 24, 1971) was a [Telugu](#) poet. Jashuva was born to Virayya and Lingamma in [Vinukonda](#), [Guntur](#), [Andhra Pradesh](#). He is legendary figure in the Telugu literary world. With his immense wisdom and through the struggle he faced due to the caste-based discrimination, Jashuva wrote his poetry with a universal approach. He was called the "Poet of the Millennium" for his timeless pieces of poetry and literature.

[Dalit](#) communities in [Andhra Pradesh](#) consider Jashuva to be the first modern Telugu Dalit poet, and actively protest his erasure from Telugu and Indian literary history. In 1995, Dalit communities in Andhra Pradesh began to organize various centennial celebrations for Jashuva's birth, and have recently begun efforts to revive the remembrance of his literary contributions.

Gabbilam (1941) is Jashuva's best known work, fashioned after [Kālidāsa's Meghadūta](#) (The Cloud Messenger), in which an exiled lover attempts to communicate his affections to his beloved wife.
