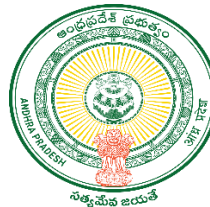
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Title: Report on Online Quiz Programme by the Department of Chemistry, Government Degree College, Chebrole

Results and Recognition:

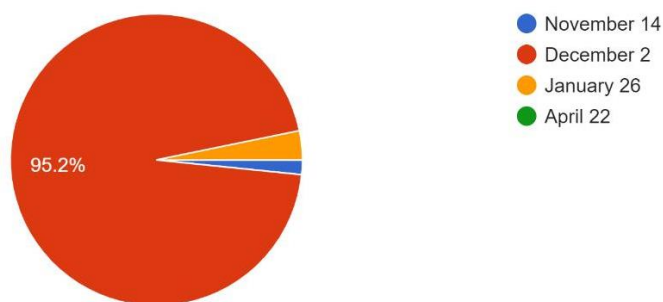

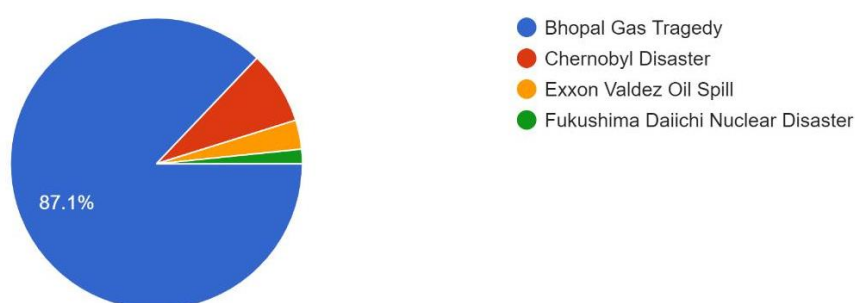
When is National Pollution Control Day observed in India?

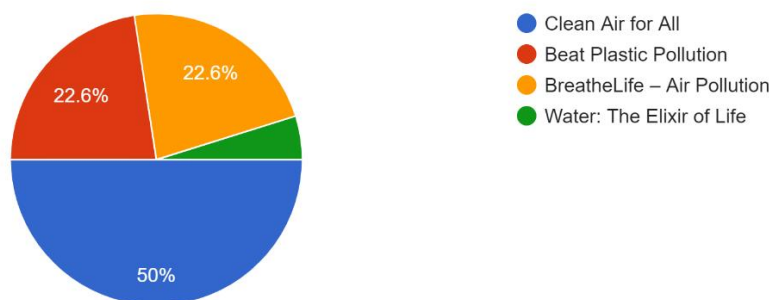
Which tragic event led to the establishment of National Pollution Control Day in India?

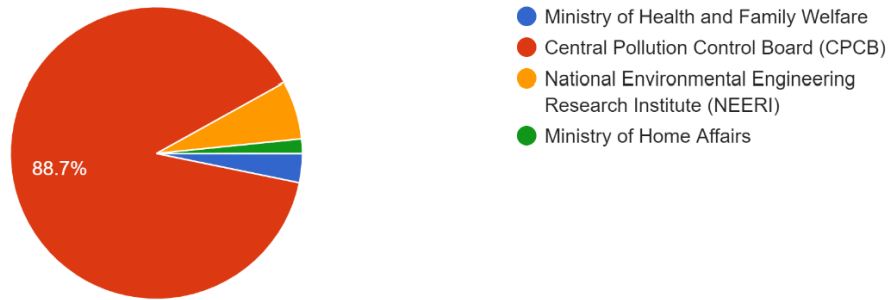
What is the theme of National Pollution Control Day 2023?

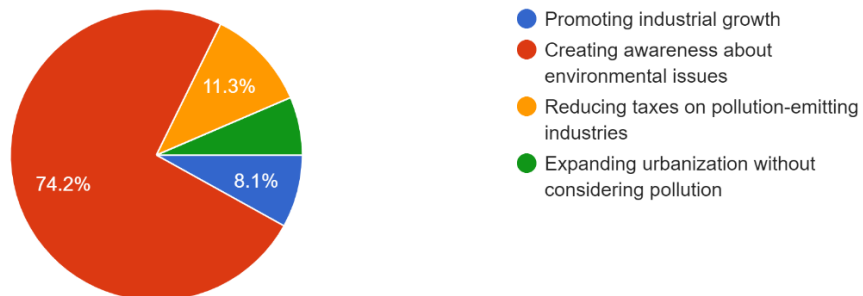
Which government agency is primarily responsible for implementing pollution control measures in India?

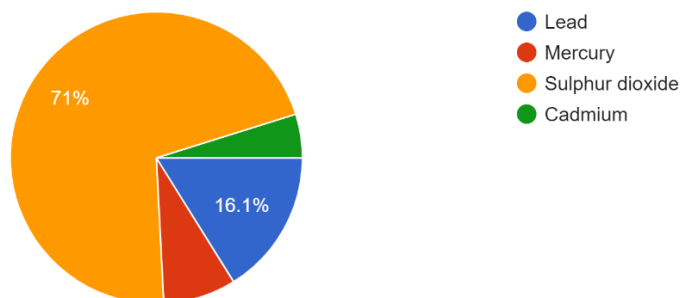

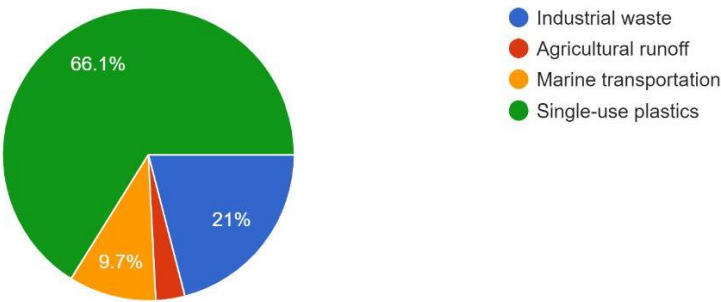
Which of the following pollutants is a major concern for air quality in urban areas?

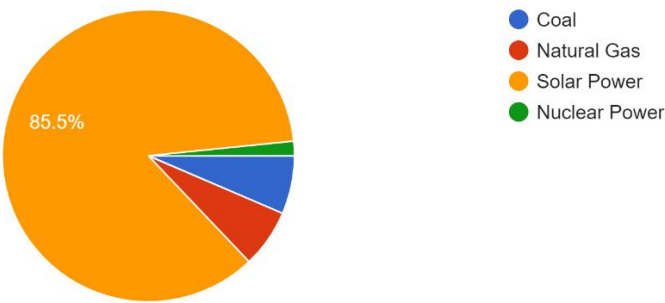

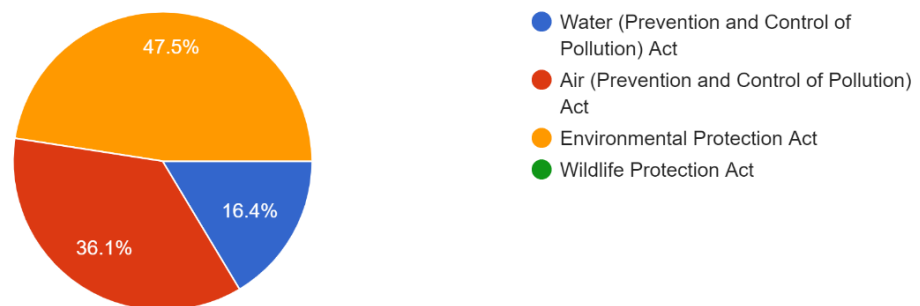

Phonetics deals with two aspects of human speech: production—the ways humans make sounds—and perception—the way speech is understood. The communicative modality of a language describes the method by which a language produces and perceives languages.

Report:

The students from GDC, Chebrole lack exposure to technology and were not aware of the Importance of phonetics that can be used in learning English Phonetics effectively. Dr.A.Nagesh briefed the students about Importance of Phonetics English Language, Grammarly, Quiz let etc., Students were involved in this Guest Lecture programme.

Phonetics is the scientific study of speech sounds, that is described and categorizing human sounds, understanding the creation of sounds, comparing and contrasting sounds diagonally language. Finding constraints and restriction of possible human speech.



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Modern phonetics began with Alexander Melville Bell (1819–1905), whose Visible Speech (1867) introduced a system of precise notation for writing down speech sounds. In the 20th century linguists focused on developing a classification system that can permit comparison of all human speech sounds.

Articulator phonetics, how sounds are made, can be useful for teachers and learners. Problems with the pronunciation of certain sounds can be discussed in terms of how they are made with the mouth, and learners can be made aware of the differences between their first language phonemes, and English phonemes.

Phonetics (from the Greek word φωνή, phone which means 'sound' or 'voice') is the science of the sounds of human speech. Someone who is an expert in phonetics is called a phonetician.

phonetics, the study of speech sounds and their physiological production and acoustic qualities. It aims to give a “systematic, conscious consideration of how speech sounds are made, what they sound like, and how they compare with each other”. Phonetics deals with the production of speech sounds by humans, often without prior knowledge of the language being spoken.

Outcome: Students evinced great interest in participation and they were amazed to know the helpful with the English Language.

6. Effective use of graphics, color and fonts.



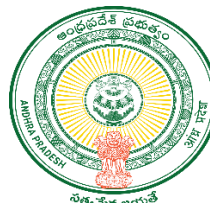
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Objective/Expected Outcome Activity:

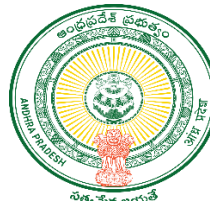
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Objective/Expected Outcome Activity:

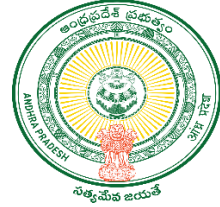


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This correspondence between the pronoun (or noun) and the verb is called AGREEMENT or CONCORD. Agreement applies only to verbs in the present tense. In the past tense, there is no distinction between verb forms: she travelled/they travelled.

Concord is a state of peaceful agreement. They pursued a balanced policy for the sake of national concord. In grammar, concord refers to the way that a word has a form appropriate to the number or gender of the noun or pronoun it relates to. Tenses are used in communication, both verbal and written, to indicate the time at which something happened. Improper usage of tenses could lead to confusion and misinterpretation of the sender's message.

Concord is the need for grammatical agreement between the different parts of speech in a sentence. The word concord comes from the Latin word for agreement. The basic rule of subject-verb agreement (concord) is very simple: a singular subject takes a singular verb, and a plural subject takes a plural verb. Subject-verb agreement means that a subject and its verb must be both singular or both plural: A singular subject takes a singular verb. A plural subject takes a plural verb.

Outcome: Concord is the need for grammatical agreement between the different parts of speech in a sentence. The word concord comes from the Latin word for agreement

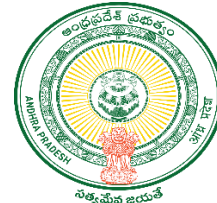
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Mathematics Day Celebration Report

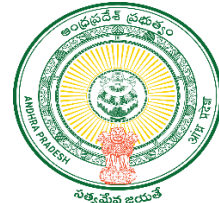
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Title: Report on Semi Christmas Eve Celebration at Government Degree College, Cheborle
